

WASHINGTON, DC – Today, Representative Michael M. Honda (San Jose, CA) commented on the positive response by Rep. Henry A. Waxman (CA-30), Chairman, US House of Representatives Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, to Rep. Honda's call for hearings into the "friendly fire" death of San Jose native, US Army Corporal Patrick Tillman:
